

Best Practices

Skill Development Program – The College is geared to make the Skill India Scheme functional. It has been sanctioned B.Voc. (in three trades) – Journalism & Mass Communication, Fashion Design & Software Technology.

Value Hub – The College has also introduced and conducts CCC, three month certificate course. Through this course students of the College and from surrounding areas are given admission. 15 students were enrolled in this session. Through this course students are trained in elementary computer education. The Computer Lab plays an active role in conducting this certificate course. UPTEC & NELIT provides certification for the programme.

Women' Health Programme

The Centre for Women's Studies (sanctioned by UGC to the College) started Health centre for the students. A senior consultant doctor from District Women's Hospital, Prayagraj visits the Centre. In the session 2018-19, a special lecture was delivered by Dr. Anjum Ahmad on Women's Health & Hygiene on 30th September, 2019 as majority of students complained of anemia and fatigue. The doctor also counseled students on balanced diet and nutrition as 40% students were found suffering from malnutrition. In addition three health check-ups of the students were conducted. The students were examined by the doctor and their blood pressure and weight were checked. The general health complaints of students were addressed and medicines were prescribed. Health card was also issued in their name.

Dental Care is a neglected area. Students complained dental problems. The Centre for Women's Studies organized a special lecture and Counseling session for students on Oral Dental Health & Hygiene. Lecture was delivered by Dr. Mohd. Hashim, Director, Soofia Dental Clinic on 12th November, 2018. Power point presentation was made and students were given dental counseling.
