

2.6.1 COURSE OUTCOME

The College holds classes in 12 conventional subjects- Ancient History, Arabic, English, Economics, Education, Geography, Medieval History, Persian, Painting, Urdu and Sociology. These subjects offer a wide range of understanding to the students in the field of liberal Arts. It enables the student to develop critical thinking, skills and information which in turn groom them to take up advanced studies at PG Level or seek jobs in the government, semi-government and private sectors. It also enables them to take up teacher education courses like B.Ed, BTC and others which shall prepare as eligible teachers. They also prepare them for competitive exams in field of civil services.

The two vocational subjects i.e Office Management & Secretarial Practices and Computer Application prepares students in computation and office management. Study of computer languages enable them to establish themselves as successful professionals in the field of computation, data analysis and record management of respective offices. It also open door of self –employment.

The PG courses in Art stream prepare students to take up Research Studies (Ph.D Courses) and seek employment in college and Universities. Similarly B.Voc Course in Fashion Designing prepares students as skilled professionals in Fashion Designing .This course provides variety of hand sewing techniques to create different kinds of Embroidery, stitches and effects such as Cross Stitch, French knot stitch, bullion Knot Stitch, shade work, Applique work English Smocking etc and expertise in the skill to stitch a variety of Flat stitches, Loop Stitches and knotted stitches. Through Fashion Designing students learn the skills and knowledge to develop fashion design briefs and manage the developments of design concepts for commercial productions. After completing one year course student is responsible for determining most effective ways to create a product or service in sewing line. Their work include analysis of sewing method and process, machine and supervision of production floor for efficiency improvement. Students have thorough knowledge of sewing process and different kind of sewing machines and equipments. The Boutique Manager course is job role of self employed professionals with knowledge of stitching, fashion, fits merchandising and retailing. Students learns thorough learning of designs, being aware of latest trends, ability to convince client for designs, capable of pattern making and skilled in stitching.

Mass Communication and journalism has emerged as a major area of interest and has immensely contributed to the development & empowerment of society. As an academic discipline, it has rapidly acquired importance and become a major attraction for students. The information technology revolution has significantly contributed to the expansion of mass media. It has also posed major challenges for

students, teachers and practitioners of mass media. The rapidly evolving technology scenario is changing the very complexion of the discipline in a manner unknown to any other area of academic activity. It is a challenge which we accept as an essential part of life in Hamidia Girl's Degree College.

Over the past decade, Hamidia Girls' Degree College has expanded its academic activities and introduced number of specialised Qualification packs in B.VOC(Journalism & Mass communication) to meet the manpower requirements of the rapidly expanding media and communication industry. The syllabus are reviewed every year to make changes and suitable modifications to make them relevant to the needs of the industry.
