History

Hamidia Girls' Degree College is a Constituent Muslim Minority College of Allahabad University functioning under the aegis of **The Association for the Education of Muslim Women at Allahabad.** It caters to the needs of modern higher education of girls and women in the densely populated Muslim dominated area. Although it is established to extend higher education to muslim girls but it has kept its doors open maintaining its accessibility to all sections of the society. The college is a unique centre of quality modern higher education and vocational skills. Presently approximately 1700 girl students are enrolled in the college in its three faculties-Faculty of Arts, Commerce and Vocations.

Milestones Covered

- Its foundation was laid in 1932 as Hamidia Primary School.
- In 1951 Hamidia School became Intermediate College.
- In 1975, the International Year of Women it turned into a Degree College with only one Faculty –Faculty of Arts.
- In 2002 Faculty of Commerce was added.
- In 2014 Faculty of Vocations was introduced.
- In 2016 Post Graduate Courses started in 4 subjects Urdu, English, Medieval History and Sociology.

Highlights

The college has many special features:

- First, its founder Begum Khursheed Khwaja, a close associate of the Father of the Nation,
 Mahatma Gandhi envisioned the development of Muslim girls only through education.
- Second, worth mentioning point here is that students come from the immediate undeserved locales as well as far-off remote areas of the city like Mau-Aima, Karchana, Naini, Mahgaon, Lohra, Shaikhpur, Peepalgaon, Katauhla, where there are no avenues of higher education for girls.
- Third, special feature of the college is that it has made consistent efforts to add more and more vocational subjects for skill development to the academic programs of the college from University Grants Commission under its different plans indicated in below given table:

C. Other Projections:

The College was sanctioned Centre for Women's Studies in 2009 by University Grants Commission. It has targeted two key areas of action —Improving Women's health and Extending legal literacy. Under its first area of action the centre established a Health Centre at the college. Consultant Doctor, Dr.Anjum Ahmad ,Senior Consultant at Zila Mahila Chikitsalaya Allahabad visits the centre and undertakes general health checkups of students and also holds Orientation Lecture on women's health and hygiene, So far 810 students have been examined. A Health Card is issued in the name of the examined student; their BP and weight are recorded. Their general health complaints are attended and acute cases are referred to Zila Mahila Chikitsalaya and MLN Medical College Allahabad. We wish to broaden the area of work so that more students be benefitted on a regular basis. The college plans to develop contacts with National Health Mission and start Women's Health Initiative. Under this we wish to start One Year Certificate Course in General Nursing and Health with twenty five seats.
