1. INTRODUCTION

Hamidia Girls' Degree College is a Constituent Minority PG College of the University of Allahabad functioning under the aegis of **The Association for the Education of Muslim Women at Allahabad**. It caters to the needs of modern higher education of girls and women and has maintained its accessibility to all sections of the society, especially Muslim girls. The College is a unique centre of quality modern higher education and vocational skills. Presently approximate 1500 girl students are enrolled in the College in three faculties and PG Courses.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Hamidia Girls' Degree College was given affiliation by the University of Allahabad in 1975. It started with six subjects in Bachelor of Arts. Then it added eight subjects. Taking forward the vision of its founder, Begum Khursheed Khawaja, and to fulfill the mission more faculties have been added - Faculty of Commerce where B. Com is functional and Faculty of Vocations where B. Voc in three trades - Journalism & Mass Com., Fashion Design and Software Technology is functional. PG classes have begun in four subjects - English, Urdu, Sociology & Medieval History as granted by the University of Allahabad in 2016. Now Research Degree Programme (Ph.D.) in Urdu sanctioned by the University of Allahabad will start from 2019-20.
- The College caters to the educational needs of students from the cross section of the society- those belonging to BPL category from the underserved adjoining locales as well as from the backward remote areas where there are no avenues of higher education exclusively for girls.
- The College envisions adding more Vocational Subjects and Vocational Courses to churn out employable graduates.
