## 1. Introduction:

Hamidia Girls' Degree College was established in 1975, the International Year of Women and functions under the aegis of **The Association for the Education of Muslim Women at Allahabad**. It caters to the needs of higher education of girls and women and has maintained its accessibility to all sections of the society, especially Muslims girls. The College is a unique center of quality modern higher education and vocational skills. Presently approximately 1500 girl students are enrolled in three faculties and P.G Courses at the College. In the ongoing session the College introduced M.Voc Course in Fashion Designing.

### **Vision:**

The Vision of the College is to make it a globally acknowledged competitive centre of excellence by providing modern, scientific, technological and value-based education accessible to the under-privileged girls of the minority community as well as other underserved segments of the society and to bring them into the mainstream of national development.

### **Highlights:**

- Haimida Girls' Degree College was given affiliation by the University of Allahabad in 1975. It started with six subjects in Bachelor of Arts. Then it added eight subjects. Taking forward the vision of the founder, Begum Khursheed Khawaja, and to fulfill the mission more faculties have been added- Faculty of Commerce where Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com) is functional and Faculty of Vocations where Bachelor of Vocations (B.Voc) in there trades- Journalism & Mass Communication, Fashion Design and Software Technology is functional. Post Graduate (P.G.) Classes are functional in five subjects – English, Urdu, Sociology, Medieval History & Education as granted by the University of Allahabad in 2016. Now Research Degree Programme (D. Phil) in Urdu shall start from the next session since as permission has been granted by University of Allahabad.

- The College caters to the educational needs of students from the cross section of the society- those belonging to BPL category from the underserved adjoining locals as well as from far-off tehsils like Chail, Phoolpur , Karchana and many students also come from the neighboring district of Pratapgarh where there are no avenues of higher education for girls.
- Lastly the College envisions to add more Vocational Subjects and Vocational Courses to churn out employable graduates.
