## 'Digital Tools for Sustaining Academic Research during Pandemic COVID 19'

## A REPORT

The College Library in collaboration with the Internal Quality Assessment Cell (IQAC), Hamidia Girls' Degree College organised a One Week Online Faculty Development Programme (FDP) on the topic 'Digital Tools for Sustaining Academic Research during Pandemic COVID 19'. The sessions were held everyday from 0300 p.m to 0500 p.m from September 7, 2020 to September 13, 2020.

The Programme was an opportunity for the academic community to discover Digital Tools that are necessary for academic research especially during the phase of lock down when they do not have physical access to libraries and institutional resources due to Pandemic COVID 19. Throughout the seven days programme, each day one Subject Knowledge Expert was invited as Resource Person to deliver his/her lecture/presentations with the motive to empower our academic community with the ability to sustain academic research irrespective of physical boundaries.

Registration to the programme was open to the academic community and library professionals of India as well as abroad through online mode. The programme was conducted on Zoom platform and was telecasted live on YouTube. Around 300 participants participated in the programme. The participants included faculty members, research scholars and library professionals from different parts of the country. Academicians from across the world like Saudi Arabia, Philippines, Egypt and Nigeria also attended the programme with great enthusiasm.

At the end of each day programme, question answer session was conducted to clear the doubts of the participants, after which feedback of participants was collected through google forms.

The Inaugural programme was held on September 7, 2020 at 3 p.m. in the presence of the Guest of Honour -Prof. Prashant Agarwal, Dean, College Development, University of Allahabad; Special Guest -Dr. B. K. Singh, University Librarian, University of Allahabad and our Resource Persons Dr. Nabi Hasan, Librarian and Head, IIT, Delhi.

The Guest of Honour, Prof. Prashant Agarwal, Dean, College Development, University of Allahabad highlighted the importance of research and said that research is an important factor for country's
