#### 1. Introduction

Hamidia Girls' Degree College is a premiere institute of the University of Allahabad and functions under the aegis of **The Association for the Education of Muslim Women at Allahabad.** It was established in 1975 and it is a gradual development of the seed sown as Hamida Primary School in 1932 by Begum Khursheed Khwaja. It started with six subjects in Faculty of Arts (B.A.) but now fourteen subjects are functional. The College has branched into 3 faculties. In 2001 Faculty of Commerce was introduced where Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com) is functional and in 2016 Faculty of Vocations was introduced where Bachelor of Vocations (B.Voc) in three trades - Journalism & Mass Communication, Fashion Design and Embroidery and Software Technology are running successfully. In the session 2019-20 M.Voc. in Fashion Design and Embroidery started. In the session 2020 -21 the UGC was sanctioned two more trades in B.Voc. Social Media & Digital Marketing, Office Administration & Secretarial Practices and one Certificate Course – Advance Pattern Maker in Fashion Design. The courses are approved by the University of Allahabad. In the session 2021-22 Ph.D. has been sanctioned in Urdu, English & Medieval History. Presently approximately 1000 girl students are enrolled in the College.

The vision of the founders of the College had been to offer quality based modern education as well as to develop the skills of the young generation. The College authorities have paid full attention to this and have been consistently introducing various vocational training programmes. In this present scenario, when higher education is taking a turn through the New Education Policy, the vision of the founders is translated into reality. The B.Voc. Degree Programme in three trades is providing quality based education. Now with the implementation of NEP in the coming session vocational and skill based education will become a part of the conventional subjects also. **Vision:**

Keeping in view the changes to be brought about the New Education Policy, the College envisions broadening the platform of education and giving full emphasis to the Skill Development Programme of the UGC. It aims at providing latest skill based technological education to students from all strata of society.




