Session was on "Orientation cum Refreshers Session on Institutions Innovation Council Objectives, Structure, Operation for IIC institutions" Distinguished speaker was respected Mr. Abhishek Ranjan Kumar Ji., Innovation Officer, MoE's INNOVATION CELL (GOVERNMENT OF INDIA). Faculty and students of the Institution Innovation Council of Hamidia Girls' Degree College attended the session.

The Program was inaugurated by Welcoming the guest by Mrs Neerja Verma, ARIIA Coordinator of IIC and Head, Dept. Of English, Hamidia Girls Degree College. The program Introduction was given by Prof. Nasreen Begum, Covener of IIC and Head, Dept. Of Ancient History, Culture & Archaeology. Respected Mr. Abhishek Ranjan ji was the Speaker for the Program, he guided students and faculty for Institutions Innovation Council Objectives, Structure, Operation for IIC institutions and How to Use those features. He took glance through various programs and schemes for IIC institutions and also take brief of Incentives and measurement of performance IIC Institutions' effort.

During the session respected Mr. Abhishek discussed the Institutional Innovation Council (IIC), which was initiated by the Ministry of Education in 2018 to help educational institutions

streamline and strengthen their innovation and startup ecosystems. He said that the IIC aims to have at least 50% of total institutions in India function effectively by 2027, making them central to the national innovation ecosystem.

The speaker Mr. Abhishek ji emphasized the importance of research, innovation, and entrepreneurship in India's education system and the challenges faced by institutions in promoting these areas. He further explained the functioning of the Council. The IIC Network was started to address these challenges and provide a framework for institutions to improve their innovation and entrepreneurship efforts. The council focuses on six pillars: *system development*, *leadership*, *structure*, *cultural* *development*, *and strategy.*

The IIC is a crucial component in measuring institutional performance and provides opportunities for students and faculty to engage with industry partners and resources. The council also offers incentives, rewards, and recognition for selected innovations. The IIC portal offers various subprograms, such as Mentor Mentee, Impact Lecture, and innovation entrepreneurship-related learning courses.

The distinguished speaker also discussed the registration process for new higher education institutions and the benefits of the IIC platform, including expert sessions, pre-incubation and incubation management, and mentor mentee and impact lecture schemes. It was a well conducted session and enriched the participants with information on IIC. 11 faculty and 42 students attended the session.

During this session, Mr. Abhishek ji introduced the Innovation Ambassador training program under the Institution Innovation Council (IIC) umbrella. The program aims to identify and train faculty members to collaboratively drive their institution's Innovation and entrepreneurship ecosystem.

The speaker emphasized the importance of empowering human resources in institutions and infusing them with a mindset of innovation and entrepreneurship.

He discussed the following IIC objectives: -

Foster interdisciplinary and cross-functional collaboration to leverage diverse perspectives and expertise.

Encourage and facilitate innovative thinking and problem-solving across various departments and disciplines.

Offer access to essential resources, including funding, mentorship, and technical support, to help startups succeed.

Foster Idea and Product Development

Actively promote and support the development of new ideas and products, providing guidance, and resources needed to refine and bring these innovations to market.

Establish partnerships with industry leaders, investors, and other stakeholders to create opportunities for startups to network, gain insights and secure funding.

****Support **Entrepreneurship* ***

Provide resources and support for individuals or teams looking to start new ventures or commercialize their ideas.

Align innovation efforts with the institution's broader strategic goals and mission.

- Members- No Limit

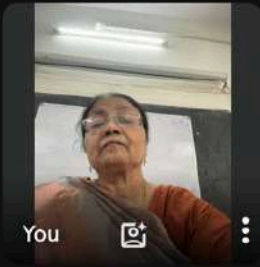
